

Student Arts Showcase 2012 – Juried Exhibition

DEADLINE FOR DIGITAL SUBMISSIONS: APRIL 9th

ELIGIBILITY:

All Cornell students are eligible to submit original works to the show. All work must be current (within the last 2 years).

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES:

- We are accepting original 2-D work no larger than 36" in any direction. We regret that we cannot accept 3-D work this year, due to space limitations. All works must be either framed or on a stretched canvas (to be hung on a wall) or matted (to be placed on a print rail). We are also accepting video work, which will be screened at the showcase event on April 21st.
- We will review up to 3 entries per person, submitted on a CD or DVD to the Museum by **5pm on April 9th**. Submit high-quality JPEGs of 2-D work and 5 minutes excerpts of video work.
- Submissions must be accompanied by an entry form (to be filled out when dropping off CD or DVD) and a titles list including: artist name and email address, title, date, medium and dimensions of work (or running time of video).
- If framed, artist must supply his/her own hardware (means of hanging the works) and must be ready to be hung. We supply only the nails and do not attach hardware to the works. It must come ready to be hung!!
- If matted, it must fit in our print rail (**no more than 30" high.**)
- We will consider a diptych or triptych as a single entry, however, we reserve the right to select only one work in the series if space is limited. Please specify on the titles list (to be submitted with the artwork/s) which work you would prefer displayed if only one fits.

SELECTION COMMITTEE/JURORS:

The selection committee will be comprised of two Johnson Museum employees, one member of the Johnson Museum Club, and one member of the History of Art Majors Society.

DROPPING OFF YOUR ARTWORK:

You will be notified by April 16th if your work has been selected.

All selected works must be dropped off at the lobby of the Johnson Museum on

THURSDAY, APRIL 19th between 9am and 5pm

NO WORKS WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER 5PM ON THURSDAY, APRIL 19th!!

When dropping off artwork, artists must fill out and submit 2 forms (label information sheet and objects received sheet). These sheets will be available at the Museum's front desk on the submission date.

Artworks will be hung on Friday, April 20th. Please be available by phone on this day as much as you can, in case we have any questions before installing your works.

There will be an opening reception for the showcase on Saturday, April 21st (7:00 – 10:00pm), which will also feature performance artists. Light refreshments will be served.
